

Enjoy Your Princess Cruise

Please attach your luggage tags, when you arrive at the pier and the porters will take your bags; please tip your porter approximately \$1-\$2 per bag.

When you check in at the cruise terminal, you will receive a boarding card. This card will be your boarding card to use to get on/off the ship, your cabin key, and your charge card while on board the ship. No cash is exchanged on the ship except in the Casino. Everything you purchase will be charged to your Onboard Account (drinks, gift shop, photos, shore excursions, etc.). The last night on the ship you will receive an itemized statement of everything you charged while on board. You may leave that amount on your credit card that was given to Princess upon check-in, or you may pay cash.

Gratuities - Princess will charge a \$14.50 Interior/Oceanview/Balcony - \$15.50 Mini Suites - \$16.50 Full Suites - per person, per day to your Onboard Account (depending on Cabin Category). This charge will cover the dining room staff and your cabin steward. If you feel that your service was above and beyond you may tip an additional amount. For drinks, your waiter will add an 18% gratuity to your drink bill.

During your Cruise there are a few ports that will "Anchor". This means you will take a tender boat from the ship to the dock in your port of call.

Always stay on ship time, and please pay attention to the time the ship leaves the port. They cannot "hold" the ship for late comers. When you disembark the ship in a port of call, please take your ID/driver's license and your boarding card; leave your birth certificate or passport locked in your cabin safe (unless the daily paper tells you otherwise). Do not rely on your cell phone for a clock on shore as they tend to change time depending on time zone and you need to stay on ship's time. Refer to the daily newsletter you receive in your stateroom each evening for correct times.

Each day or night you will receive a newsletter in your stateroom listing the next day's activities.
